Day Trip in Indiana

Graves of the Reno Gang

During and shortly after the Civil War, Seymour was a prominent railway hub. It became the sight of the first organized train robbery in America by the Reno Gang. The Reno Gang sparked future organized gangs and vigilante groups. The graves of three members of the gang can still be found in Seymour's historic City Cemetery along with a memorial.

For beverage enthusiasts, you might stop at Chateau de Pique Winery & Brewery for a refreshment.
