Day Trip in Indiana

Prophetstown State Park

One of the newest additions to the Indiana State Park system, [Prophetstown State Park](#) offers a multitude of opportunities just miles north of Lafayette. A living-history museum highlights the history of homesteading and native cultures from the area, Prophetstown State Park Aquatic Center has a 4,200-square-foot leisure pool is accompanied by waterslides and a lazy river. There are also hiking and biking trails, as well as a campground.

Adjacent to Prophetstown the [Tippecanoe Battlefield and Museum](#) memorializes an 1811 clash between native inhabitants and new settlers for history buffs.

Another popular stop in the Lafayette area is reasonably-priced [Columbian Park Zoo](#), with a train that will take you around the park in dry weather.

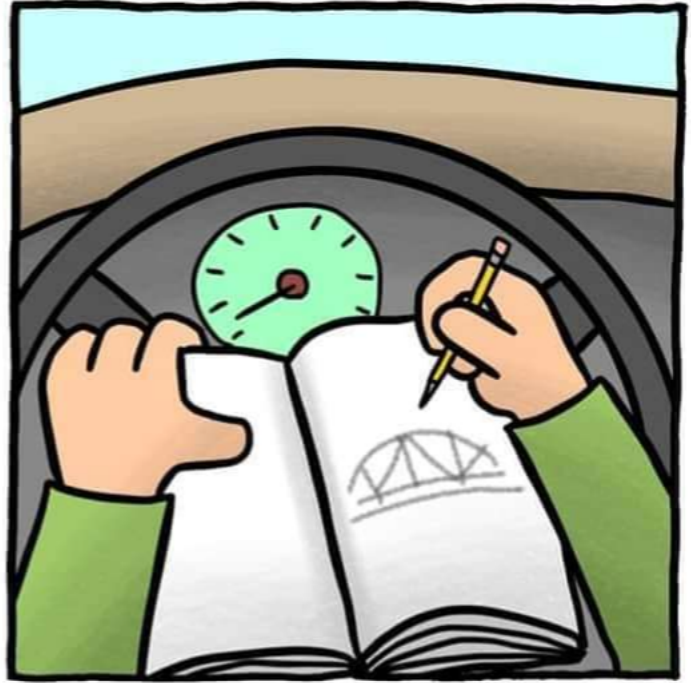
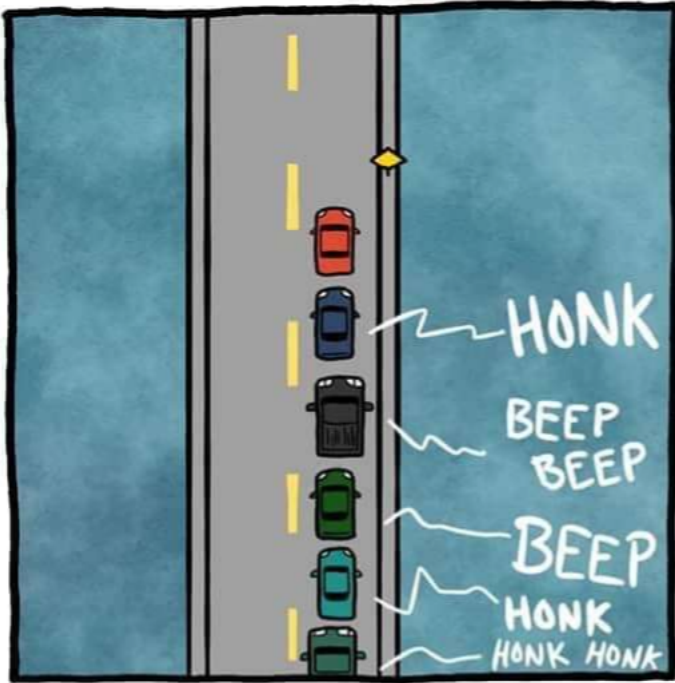
