[Indiana Dunes National Park](#)

The newest addition to the National Park system, [Indiana Dunes National Park](#) was created over 14,000 years ago when glaciers passed over the area. Located between Gary and Michigan City on the shore of Lake Michigan, this park offers something for just about everyone in beaches, prairies, wetlands, savannas, and forests. The area is tied to the history of steel production in the US, which is still visible in the skyline surrounding the park.

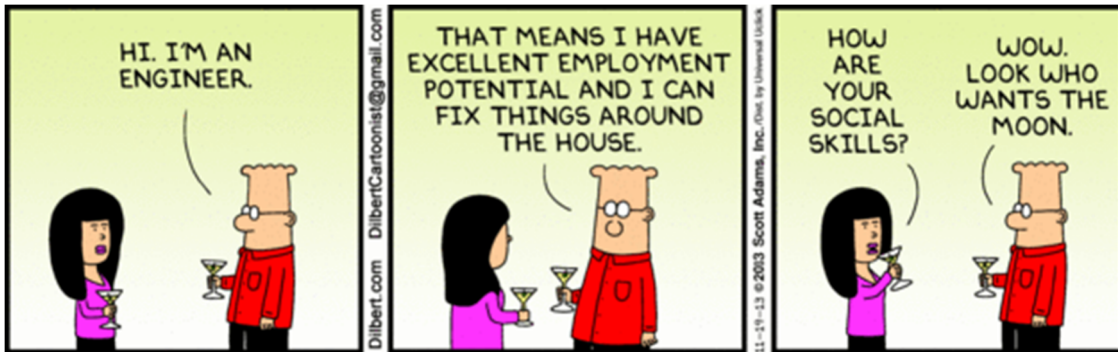
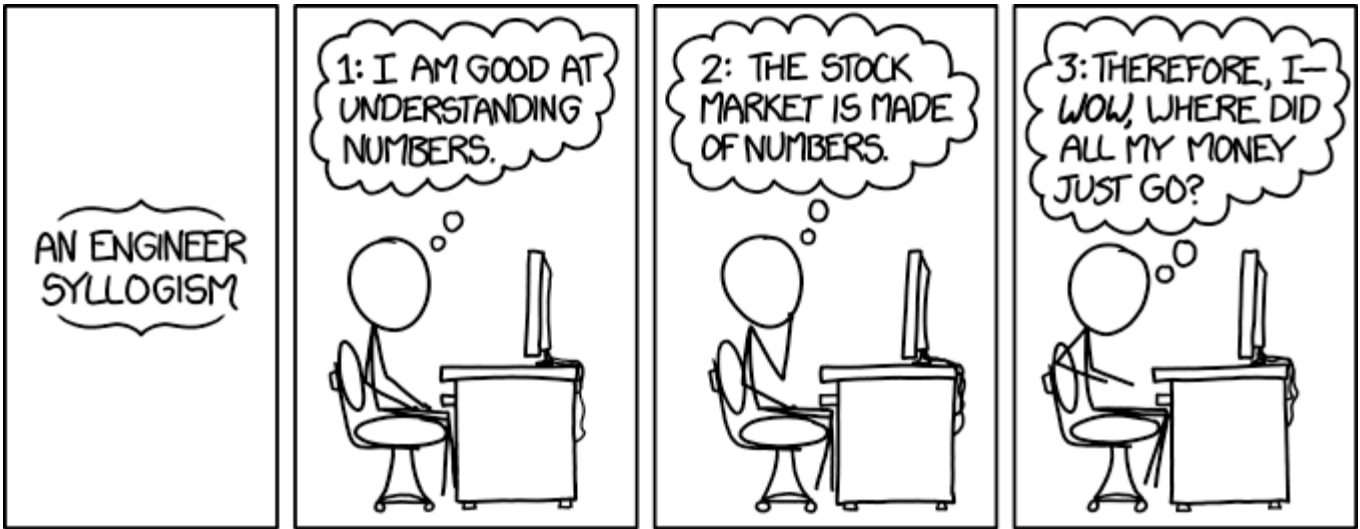
