Distinguished Member Award

Application Deadline: September 30

The highest recognition of notable and outstanding professional achievement and service to the Indiana Section of ITE is receiving the Distinguished Member Award. The Distinguished Member Award is awarded annually as an honorary designation presented to a member of the Section who has provided outstanding and significant contributions to the Indiana Section of ITE over a period of many years. The award will be presented to the winner at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering in early December.

AWARD:

- Recognition at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering, Newsletter, Website and other media
- Wall Plaque

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS:

- The nominee must be a member, in good standing, of ITE International and the Indiana Section, involved in Section activities over many years;
- The nominee's work accomplishments and their contributions to the transportation system and transportation engineering profession, including papers, presentations, positions held, etc.;
- As a general guide, candidates should normally be at least fifty years of age.

PROCEDURES/SCHEDULE OF SUBMISSION FOR AWARD CONSIDERATION:

- Only one recipient will be named each year, and an award need not be presented each year. Posthumous awards may be made, and do not count toward the yearly count of one.
- Nominations may be submitted in confidence using the attached form at any time to the Indiana Section of ITE Awards Committee Chairperson.
- Nomination submittal shall include a detailed description of the nominee's significant contributions to the Indiana Section of ITE or Student Chapter, including their work history and significant work accomplishments over a period of many years.
- Nominations shall be emailed (.pdf format) to the Secretary of ITE (secretary@indianaite.org).
- Distinguished Members shall be elected by a majority of the Section Board at or around November 15th of each year. If an individual is selected, the Indiana Section President will contact that individual as soon as possible to inform them of their election. Any discussions held during the voting process will be held in strict confidence.
- The nominees from each year will be kept by the ITE Indiana Section Awards Committee Chairperson for 2 years. After 2 years the Indiana Section Board Members can vote to keep a nominee on a continued and confidential list and/or eliminate anyone still on the 2-year list. The list of nominees shall be kept by the current Awards Committee Chairperson and passed on to the incoming Awards Committee Chairperson from year to year.

- Current members of the ITE Indiana Section Board and Student Members are not eligible to receive this award.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

Nominations may be submitted by any current member of the Indiana Section of ITE. Self-nominations are permitted.

Nominations shall be emailed (PDF Format) **no later than September 30** to the Secretary of ITE (secretary@indianaite.org).

Nominations should include:

- A description of the nominee's contributions to the Indiana Section of ITE, including offices held, written contributions, presentations and /or committee involvements, etc.
- Nominee's achievements in the transportation profession of the last calendar year.
- A brief description explaining why the nominee is deserving of the Transportation Professional of the Year Award.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Awards Committee of ITE Indiana Section will strongly consider the variety and extent of the Nominee's contributions to the Indiana Section of ITE and the Nominee's contributions to the transportation industry. The Committee may elect to not award the Transportation Professional of the year award for a given calendar year.

Transportation Achievement Award

Application Deadline: September 30

PURPOSE:

The Transportation Achievement Award may be awarded annually for excellence in the advancement of transportation to meet human needs, by entities concerned with transportation such as governmental agencies, legislative bodies, consulting firms, and other organizations. One Award may be awarded for projects covering categories including Complete Streets, Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSMO), Safety, Planning and Traffic Engineering. This award will recognize an organization for one or more of the following:

1. Development of an innovative concept in Complete Streets, TSMO, safety, planning or traffic engineering;
2. Implementation of a challenging transportation program through perseverance in its development and promotion;
3. Program or project having a significant effect on transportation;
4. Multi-faceted transportation program or project, combining many innovative and/or well-applied concepts;
5. Program or project promoting a major advancement in the efficiency and/or economy of transportation.

AWARD:

- Recognition at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering, Newsletter, Website and other media
- Wall Plaque

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS:

- Governmental agencies/entities
- MPO/LPO agencies
- Private businesses or corporations
- Combined public/private institutions
- Academic institutions

PROCEDURES/SCHEDULE OF SUBMISSION FOR AWARD CONSIDERATION:

Nominations and/or applications may be made by both members and non-members of ITE. The nomination submission should include pertinent information and, if applicable, photographs. The submittal should be in PDF format and limited to five (5) pages that describe the project with graphics included and indicate how the project meets the criteria for the award. The submission should assist the awards committee in evaluating the project against the selection criteria. A project may encompass multiple categories of enhancement to the transportation system. The winner will be submitted to the Great Lakes District of ITE for their consideration and awards program.

- **30 Points** – Strong applicability to the industry
- **10 Points** – Well-balanced scope and format

The award will be presented to the winner at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering in early December.

AWARD:

- Recognition at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering, Newsletter, Website and other media
- Wall Plaque

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS:

- The nominee must be a member, in good standing, of ITE International and the Indiana Section.
- Nominee must be 35 years of age or younger on December 1st of the award year.
- Nominee is NOT currently a STUDENT member.
- Current members of the ITE Indiana Section Board and Student Members are not eligible to receive this award.

NOMINATION PROCESS:

Nominations may be submitted by any current member of the Indiana Section of ITE.

Nominations shall be emailed (PDF Format) **no later than September 30** to the Secretary of ITE (secretary@indianaite.org).

Required information includes:

- One (1) testimonial from a current or past Section Officer (200-word maximum)
- One (1) recommendation from a current or past supervisor (200-word maximum)
- Three (3) examples of specific project experience with a description of the individual's role in each project (150-word maximum/each)

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Awards Committee of ITE Indiana Section will consider the variety and extent of the Nominee's contributions to the Traffic Engineering/Transportation Planning industry and/or the Indiana Section of ITE and vote accordingly for the winner. The winner of the Indiana Section of ITE Rising Star Award will be forwarded to the Great Lakes District of ITE for consideration of the GLD Rising Star Award.

Student Paper Award

Application Deadline: September 30

PURPOSE:

The Student Paper Award may be awarded annually for a significant paper prepared by a student member of ITE. The purpose of the award is to encourage ITE student members to conduct and report on independent and original research and investigate transportation subjects and to provide a means for recognizing outstanding accomplishments in this area.

AWARD:

- Recognition at the ITE Indiana Section Annual Holiday Gathering, Newsletter, Website and other media
- Wall Plaque

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANTS:

Any individual member of ITE who:

- Is a student member of Indiana Section ITE; and
- Completed work providing a basis for the paper while a student member of Indiana Section ITE.

PROCEDURES OF SUBMISSION FOR AWARD CONSIDERATION:

Papers must be submitted to the Secretary of ITE (secretary@indianaite.org) no later than September 30.

1. Papers must address a transportation topic.
2. Must be authored by one student author, advisors can be listed but CANNOT be co-authors.
3. Paper must be submitted in English.
4. A PDF document in 11 pt. type, with a maximum of 3,000 words.
5. Paper must include a title page showing title, author's name, address, telephone number, and date. Paper must also include a table of contents.

The winner will be submitted to the Great Lakes District of ITE for their consideration and awards program.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- **20 Points** – Originality
- **20 Points** – Significance in the field of Traffic Engineering/Transportation Planning
- **20 Points** – Scope and Format regarding the paper's relationship to its stated purpose.
- **20 Points** – Validity
- **20 Points** – Applicability
